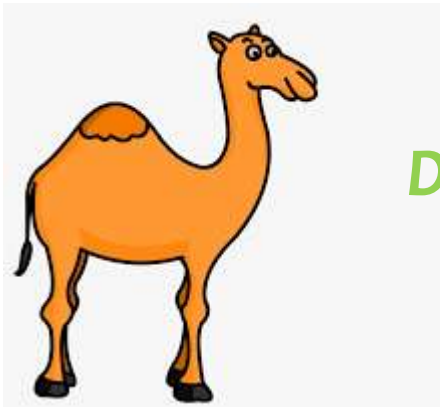
## Paper Quelling Activity

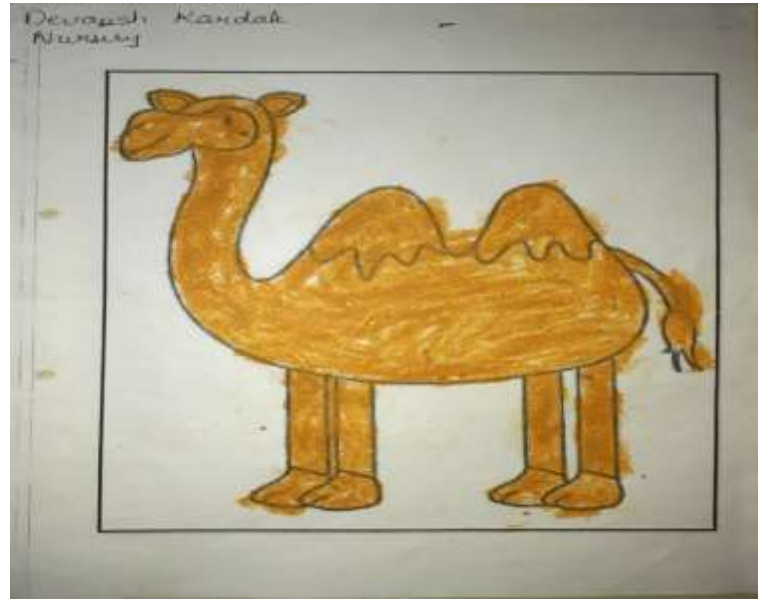
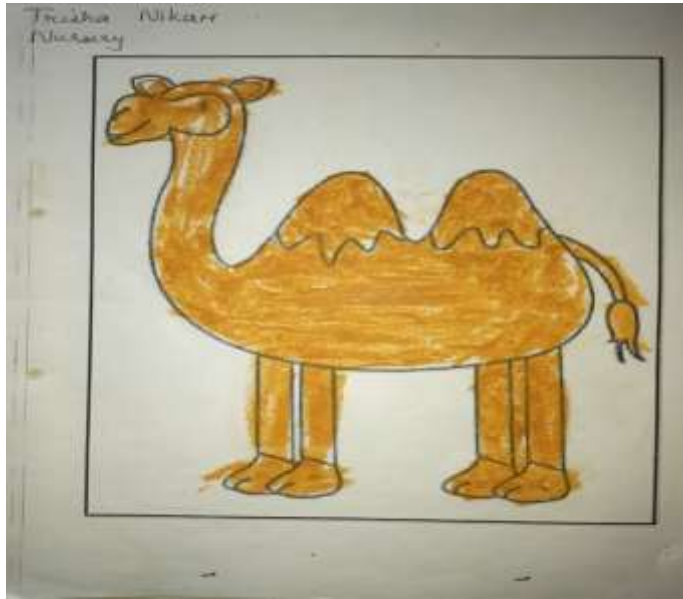
