Academics

ICSE Curriculum

Other than language groups we have Mathematics, EVS (Environmental science) or Social Science Studies, Computer, General Knowledge, Value Education or Life skills and Physical Education, Performing Art, Music, Dance etc

Co-Curricular Activities
